CONTEST

- Online Application: Submitting an online form: general information, a PowerPoint business plan up to 12 slides (including at least one on financials), and a 2minute video introducing the company
- Selection Process: All submitted applications will be reviewed and screened by our Selection Committee based on the quality of applications. 6-8 semi-finalists will be chosen and invited to compete in front of a Judging Committee to select 2-3 finalists. An Investment Committee will conduct detailed due diligence research on the finalists to determine whether an investment will be made based on the technology platform merits, cancer patient impact, and potential for return on investment. The company that passes the due diligence will be eligible to receive investment from AIM-HI and co-investors.
- Our three-track Selection, Judging and Investment Committees consist of world-class life sciences industry professionals, business leaders, and investors

ELIGIBILITY

- Women-led oncology companies seeking pre-seed, seed and Series A investments
- Must have a woman in senior leadership who has an equity stake could be founder or C-level executive
- Must have technology ownership in place

- Top finalists will be awarded honorariums and recognized with certificates
